

**Glatzová & Co. successfully represented an insolvency administrator in a dispute against O2 Czech Republic a.s.**

Glatzová & Co. successfully represented Langmeier & Co., insolvenční správci v.o.s., acting as the insolvency administrator of the law firm Kubištová & Co., v.o.s. We represented the insolvency administrator in a long-running dispute against O2 Czech Republic a.s. concerning the payment of fees owed to Kubištová & Co., v.o.s. for representation in thousands of enforcement proceedings.

The insolvency of the law firm, with debts amounting to hundreds of millions of Czech crowns, represented one of the most unusual cases of recent years. The principal dispute with O2 Czech Republic a.s., whose origins dated back nearly 20 years, concerned a claim for fees following the annulment of Decree No. 484/2000 Coll. (the so-called “tariff decree”) by the Constitutional Court. The dispute was ultimately resolved by the payment of CZK 23 million into the insolvency estate, which will be used to satisfy creditors.

In addition to representing the client in mediation and settlement negotiations, our law firm also devised a distribution mechanism for the proceeds reflecting the realities of the insolvency proceedings. Ultimately, five secured creditors were granted the right to satisfaction from collateral with respect to the claim, while part of the claim remained unsecured and will be used to satisfy creditors from interim financing and unsecured registered creditors. These complex procedural issues were also successfully resolved with the contribution of our team.
